

Massachusetts Partnership with Sentinel Offender Services for Statewide GPS Program

Sex offenders tracked through state-based electronic monitoring center

Background

There are currently more than 500,000 registered sex offenders nationwide, and many states have passed or are considering laws that will make electronic monitoring mandatory for life for convicted sex offenders. Managing this growing caseload presents a challenge for law enforcement and probation agencies.

The Challenges

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts wanted to implement a statewide Global Positioning Satellite (GPS) electronic monitoring program for sex offenders. Massachusetts desired a reliable GPS monitoring solution that integrated well with their existing monitoring platform. Had this program proved unsuccessful, Massachusetts faced the potential loss of public support for electronic monitoring initiatives, potential lawsuits, and worst of all, some sex offenders might have gone without adequate supervision.

Solution

Sentinel Offender Services provided the Massachusetts Probation Commissioner's Office with a customized solution. Sentinel Offender Services placed personnel on-site to work directly with the customer to ensure flawless program implementation. Approach

Once the monitoring application was deployed, Sentinel Offender Services worked with the probation commissioner’s office to install the new software application to enroll offenders and train Massachusetts Probation staff.

The Outlook

Sentinel Offender Services exceeded customer expectations by being on-site during the program startup and by continuing to look for ways to improve the program. The Massachusetts Probation program is now growing. The Probation Commission has added some 200 offenders within the last 18 months and likely will add about 600 more over the next number of months. The current task is to continue developing new technology that will increase efficiency as the program grows.

Sentinel Offender Services is currently developing new additions to the tracking software to reduce the amount of labor involved in tracking equipment. Sentinel Offender Services is also providing new mapping capability that will allow Massachusetts to more easily review the offender location. We are also providing new technology that will increase the monitoring capabilities of the agency.
